

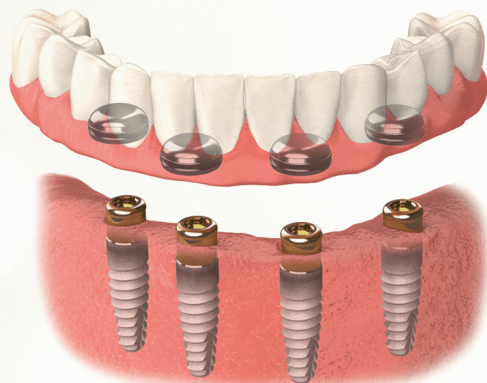
## Removable Dentures



- Provide the appearance of natural teeth.
- Will need to use denture adhesive.
- May start to loosen and shift over time.
- Prolong usage will cause jawbone to shrink.
- Most cost-effective method for replacing missing teeth.
- Overtime can become uncomfortable and hinder speech and eating.
- Relines necessary to adjust fit.



## 6-Implant Snap - On Overdenture (Upper) 4-Implant Snap - On Overdenture (Lower)



- Much better retention than a removable denture.
- Can be removed by patient to clean and while you sleep at night.
- Denture will cover the roof of your mouth.
- Will alter lip support, speech, and your bite.
- Maintains healthy underlying bone.
- Most affordable and practical way to replace all teeth with dental implants.
- Bi-yearly maintenance required by a restorative dentist and insert attachments will need to be replaced periodically.

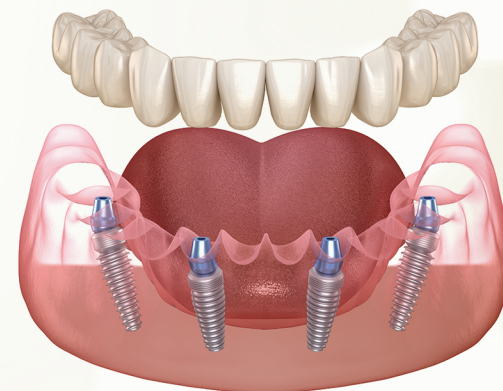

## All on 4®



- Allow you to replace 12 teeth in an arch with 4 dental implants.
- Natural Appearance and the best option.
- Does not cover the roof of your mouth.
- "Fixed Prosthesis" permanently attached with small screws to dental implants.
- Custom made zirconia or acrylic bridge.
- Can only be removed by a dentist.
- Will alter lip support, speech, and your bite.
- In most cases you will have a screwed in prosthesis the day of the surgery.
- Bi-yearly maintenance required by a restorative dentist or prosthodontist.
